Improving Bronx Waterways

The Bronx Board of Trade reports that the improvement of various waterways in the borough is progressing at a very satisfactory rate. The engineers of the War Department, it is stated, have received appropriations of \$227,000 for completion of the work in straightening the channel in the Harlem River near the old Johnson iron works at Spuyten Duyvil; \$90,000 for dredging the Harlem River and \$30,000 for maintenance dredging of Westchester Creek. Work on the Harlem River project at Spuyten Duyvil, it is stated, is well ahead of schedule and is expected to be finished early in the Winter.
